All this time, I have been using a delegate by naming it and typing in the parameters. There comes a day where I need to make a delegate private and I stumble upon this: public delegate void SomeDelegate(T item); If I had a private delegate, how would I call it using the modifier? A: I can't imagine how any type would be any more strongly typed than "Object" so it seems silly to make that a generic type It's still pretty strong typing, unless the method/class that accepts the delegate allows for some "semi-additional" details. That is: public void DoSomething(T item) where T: SomeSpecifcType { var identifier = item as SomelIdentifier; // do something } This works as long as DoSomething can take any delegate. I do like the ability to specify the delegate type in a generic method/class, but that's something you get from Mono/MonoTouch/NuGet. EDIT: I was also curious about how you would define such a method/class. It's rather simple in a generic fashion... Public class SomeClass { public void DoSomething(T item) where T: SomeSpecifcType { var identifier = item as SomelIdentifier; // do something } } If you want to keep the generic methods, you can
